



REMINDERS



PADDLE BOARDS - If you are using a paddle board on any Birchwood Lake, PA Fish & Boat regulations require that a USCG approved wearable life jacket **must** be on board for everyone using the board; that it is highly advisable that all paddle board users wear their jacket; that all children 12 years of age or younger must wear their life jacket when underway. It is also required that an emergency, sound producing device, such as an athletic coach's whistle, be on board (suggested it be clipped to the life jacket). These rules are for your safety. Please comply.



NO OPEN FIRES

No uncontained outdoor fires are permitted in Birchwood Lakes. Uncontained fires are defined as: A. campfires, B. Bonfires, C. Burning of leaves. Please see **Rules & Regulations Section 98-50-9 Burning** for more information.



Section 98 - 50 - 3 Possession of firearms on B.L.C.A. property – amended effective 9/16/14

- A. It shall be unlawful to be on any road or Birchwood Lakes Community Association property while in possession of any firearm, bow and arrows, BB gun, Pellet Gun or any other device capable of propelling a projectile of any kind. The only exception to this regulation shall be individuals who are law enforcement officers and/or individuals who have a license to carry permit under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- B. It shall be unlawful to be in possession of any firearm, bow and arrows, BB gun, Pellet Gun or any other device capable of propelling a projectile of any kind while in any Birchwood Lakes buildings, Pool, Playground, Lakes or Beach areas or any other recreational facility.
- C. **The fine for violation of Section 98 - 50 - 3: A shall be \$250.00.**

SEPTIC TANKS

Postcards were mailed out January 2017 to those members who have had their septic tanks pumped/inspected in 2012. This is a reminder that you need to provide the office with documentation before December 31, 2017 to avoid receiving a citation. Note: A septic tank that is being repaired and/or replaced requires a permit and a final CO. Please call the office if you have any questions.

ANIMALS

Leashed pets are permitted at all common areas between Labor Day weekend and Memorial Day weekend. **Beach 2** is allocated as a dog friendly beach all-year around. All owners must pick up after their pets.

The office has been receiving many complaints about **feral cats**.

Section 98-50-8 Feeding Wildlife Prohibited.

It shall be prohibited to place or offer any food or enticement on any property located within BLCA which results in attracting and feeding, deer, bear, waterfowl, turkey and **feral cats**.

The fine for violation of section 98-50-8A shall be \$25.00.
